If you are an employer, you can attend for free and learn about Canada’s economic immigration programs and resources to help you attract, hire and retain global talent. You will have the opportunity to ask questions.

- ❖ **Global Skills Strategy (GSS):** Learn about how the strategy helps employers attract top talent through faster application processing times, work permit exemptions and enhanced customer service.
- ❖ **Hiring Express Entry Candidates:** Learn about the economic immigration programs under Express Entry and how you can hire Express Entry candidates to meet your labour needs when you can’t fill job vacancies locally.
- ❖ **New Atlantic Immigration Program:** The Atlantic Immigration Pilot was launched in 2017 to help employers in Atlantic Canada hire foreign workers who want to immigration to Atlantic Canada and international graduates who want to stay in region after graduation. Due to its success, the government has committed to making the pilot a permanent program in 2022. Learn about this new permanent program, which will continue to be a flagship regional economic immigration program in the Atlantic Provinces.
